

Cooperation Agreement  
Between the congregation of XX, XXcountry  
and the congregation of Christian Parish in XXtown, Denmark

The parish councils of the congregation of WW and the congregation of Christian Parish hereby declare that our two parishes are to be regarded as friendship parishes.

That means that we will aim at:

- exchanging information about the daily life of our countries, churches, and parishes with their joys, sorrows, and problems.
- Entering into an open, democratic dialogue, where the two parties give inspiration to each other in the light of their different nations, peoples, churches, cultural (?) and social backgrounds.
- Including our joys, sorrows, and problems in our intercessions, both during church services and in private prayer, being members of the same body of Christ (1. Cor. 12:12-13), who need our mutual help and strengthen our faith, hope and love.
- Establishing personal relationship between members of our congregations in:
  - --- correspondence between young people and grown-ups in our congregations.
  - --- mutual visits by private individuals and groups with a view to establishing friendships, and giving inspiration and support.
  - --- giving material and economic assistance from one parish to the other in accordance with the biblical principle of balance (2. Cor. 8:13-15), one party helping the other now, and possibly reciprocal aid later on..
